2. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2 The 2022 Italian Offshore Federal regulation.
- 2.3 For the offshore regatta the World Sailing Offshore Special regulation for **Category 3** races will apply **with the commitment of the life raft and AIS transponder** which shall be active all the regatta long.
- 2.4 The OPEN Class boats are not required to have the life raft nor the AIS transponder but shall be in compliance with the safety equipment as required for sailing within 6 miles from the shore.
- 2.5 During nights the sunrise starting signal International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS) will apply also to racing boats (these substitute RRS Part 2).
- 2.6 Technical races on marks will be governed by Special ORC Regulations for Category 4 regattas.
- 2.7 2022 ORC rules.



- 2.8 If there is a conflict between the rules, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail (this change RRS 63.7).

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The “Settimana Velica Internazionale” is open to the follow categories: ORC, ORC X2, OPEN and OPEN X2”.
- 3.2 **ORC:** All boat with a valid International ORC certificate or ORC Club (ORC) are eligible.
The groups will be made as per the “Normativa FIV per la vela d’altura 2022” (national regulation).
MINIALTURA boats are eligible if they have a valid 2022 ORC measurement certificate. The required number of boats to create the Minialtura group is 5 boats.
- 3.3 **OPEN:** boats without an ORC measurement certificate (called OPEN) may join the regatta and will be divided according to their LOA in the following classes:
- Maxi: more than 16,00 m
- Zero: from 13,51 m to 16,00 m
- Alfa: from 12,01 m to 13,50 m
- Bravo: from 11,01 m to 12,00 m
- Charlie: from 10,26 m to 11,00 m
- Delta: from 9.51 m to 10,25 m
- Echo: from 8,76 m to 9,50 m
- Foxtrot: from 7,81 m to 8,75 m
- Golf: from 6,81 m to 7,80 m
- Hotel: from 6,50 m to 6,80 m
- 3.4 If a class will not reach 3 registered boats, these boats will join the closer class.
- 3.5 Offshore 650 and UFO, ZERO and METEOR, if will make a class if will not be less than 5, otherwise will gain the Open class of relevance.
- 3.6 The OC reserves to accept boats registrations or classes not included in the previous points.



- 3.7 **X2:** boats competing only in “Trieste – San Giovanni in Pelago – Trieste” Offshore regatta can register also with a two-member crew (X2).
In this case, as required by OSR 6.01.3, one of the members **shall have the certificate of the attendance of the “Offshore Personal Survival” class** as per OSR – Section 6. Only ORC X2 and OPEN X2 are eligible to the X2 offshore regatta.
- 3.8 The OC reserves to not accept boats which will not give sufficient safety guarantee for the offshore racing.
- 3.9 Once a boat is registered in a category, this category cannot change during the Championship. For example: if a boat is register in the ORC category for the “Settimana Velica Internazionale” it cannot race the offshore race inside the X2 category also if it has a valid ORC X2 certificate.

4. SCHEDULE

H 10.25 – First warning signal for the technical races on the ORC category
- Friday, September 23rd
H 18.30 Briefing – it will be notified on the online notice board
H 22.25 First warning of the offshore regatta “Trieste – San Giovanni in Pelago – Trieste” for all categories ORC, ORC X2, OPEN and OPEN X2.
- **Saturday, September 24th**
 If the offshore regatta cannot take place, all boats will race a costal race with the warning signal scheduled at **10.55**
- **Sunday, September 25th**
H 10.25 – First warning signal for the technical races on the ORC category

4.2 During the technical racing day, a maximum of 3 races can be sailing on each day. The ORC fleet can race a maximum of 9 windward-leeward races.

4.3 No warning signal can be given after 15.30 of Sunday September 25th

5. ENTRY AND MEMBERSHIP

All competitors shall comply with RRS 19 – Eligibility code and shall be in compliance with their MNA membership included the medical prescriptions.

6. REGISTRATIONS

6.1 Registration shall be made by:

- Settimana Velica Internazionale: h. 19.00 of Friday September 16th
- 61° offshore regatta “Trieste - San Giovanni in Pelago - Trieste”: h19.00 of Thursday September 22nd

No entries will be accepted after these deadlines

9. MEASUREMENTS

Measurement, crew, boat and equipment compliance will be make before, during and after the event. Any re-measurement or sail update shall be made before 16h September, with a previous agreement with the Organizing Committee.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions for “Settimana Velica Internazionale“ and the offshore regatta will be available online on the event website and on the dedicated page on the website www.racingrulesofsailing.org.

11. VENUE

- 11.1 The official regatta headquarter is the Yacht Club Adriaco
- 11.2 The windward-leeward course will be in the gulf of Trieste.
- 11.3 Offshore race will be raced on the course Trieste (start in front of Piazza dell'Unità d'Italia), San Giovanni in Pelago island, out of Rovigno (Croatia), and back to Trieste, as described in the sailing instruction maps.
- 11.4 The potential costal race will be raced in the Trieste gulf.



12. RESULTS AND SCORING

ORDINARY RULES:

- 12.1 Classes may be split into groups according to numbers of participants, ORC ratings and 2022 Italian Offshore Federal regulation, and to the LOA for the OPEN classes.
- 12.2 In case of ties, the offshore result or the costal race shall prevail. If none of these races will be sailed, the last race of the series shall prevail.
- 13.8 The series will be valid also with only one race sailed.

ORC CLASS:

- 12.4 Result will be determined by corrected times calculated using the rating system for each classes and groups.
- 12.5 As per Italian “Normativa” the class results will be extract from the overall ranking
- 12.6 The worst result may be discarded if 4 or more races will be sailed. The offshore or costal race cannot be discarded.
- 12.7 The ORC boats with a “minialtura” certificate will have a separate ranking.
- 12.8 These race rating will be used:
- Offshore race: 1,5
 - Costal rate – alternative to the offshore race -: 1,2
 - Windward-leeward course: 1,0

OPEN CLASS:

- 12.9 Real time results will be made

13. PRIZES

- 13.1 First three classified for each ORC groups for the “Settimana Velica Internazionale”.



13.2 First classified for ORC and OPEN class groups for the “61st Trieste San Giovanni in Pelago Trieste”.

13.3 The traditional “challenge” CUPS will be assigned:

- “**Trofeo Ammiraglio di Squadra Angelo Monassi**” Line Honours X2 on the offshore race.
- “**Coppa Ammiraglio Straulino**” to the best club classified at the offshore race “Trieste San Giovanni in Pelago Trieste” considering the best three partial result in each classes ORC and OPEN, with a total of 9 individual result in force.
- “**Coppa Gabrio de Szombathely**” to the first boats who finish the offshore race “Trieste San Giovanni in Pelago Trieste” regardless the class or the course.
- “**Coppa Piero Brückner**” to the first “overall” classified at the offshore race in the ORC classes.
- “**Coppa Pino Machne**” to the first “overall” classified at the “Settimana velica intenazionale” in the ORC classes.
- “**Coppa On. dott. Fausto Pecorari**” to the first classified in the first ORC group at the “Settimana velica intenazionale”.
- “**Coppa Cap. Piero Fragiacomò**” to the first classified in the second ORC group at the “Settimana velica intenazionale”.
- “**Coppa Myrtò**” to the younger skipper registered at the “Settimana velica intenazionale”
- “**Trofeo i Due Fari**”, Memorial Salpietro/Patella to the first under 12 mt boat rounding the San Giovanni in Pelago Island

13.4 The OC reserves the authority to assign other prices.

14. ADVERTISING

Advertising is permitted according to Rule 20 World Sailing. The Organizing Authority may ask competitors to display sponsor stickers for all the events.

15. DISCALIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1 Each skipper is responsible of his crew ability to attend a Category 3 and/or Category 4 regatta.



15.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, see RRS 3 - Decision to Race.

15.3 The Organizing Authority, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. HOSPITALITY

For boats attending the “International sailing week”, will be provided hospitality from 14th to 28th of September at the club moorings prior a written request on the entry form. All moorings shall be cleared within the “8th September to allow the arrival of Classic boats attending the “Raduno Città di Trieste”.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with the cover to things and people, with a minimum coverage of 1.500.000,00 €, including coverage during races.

18. MEDIA RIGHTS

Owners and sailors allow and give full rights to the OC and Sponsors about the use of the image rights (personal and of the boats) giving the full consent using their name or bio on any kind of publications (images, movies or advertising) to use on media, Tv or internet. Owners and sailors authorize the publication and/or communication with any kind of press related picture or movie of people or boats during the event, including and not restricted to TV advertising and all can be used for press or advertising release or for info regarding the event. The acceptance of the above rights by any crew members is an essential part of the boat registration. The OC may ask the chance to host onboard video or photo maker. The operator will not be considered as a crew member and cannot take part in any maneuvers or onboard activities tied to the setup of the boat during the races. The OC reserves the chance to disembark the operator before the end of the race and, in accordance with the boat captain, evaluating the best moment to do this procedure without interfering with the race. The operator attendance cannot be ground for any protest or request of redress. This change RRS 62.1(a).
